Overview

The **Direxion Daily MSCI Brazil Bull 2X Shares** seeks daily investment results, before fees and expenses, of 200% of the performance of the MSCI Brazil 25/50 Index. **There is no guarantee that the fund will achieve its stated investment objective.**

This leveraged ETF seeks a return that is 200% of the return of its benchmark index **for a single day. The fund should not be expected to provide two times the return of the benchmark's cumulative return for periods greater than a day.**

Target Index

The MSCI Brazil 25/50 Index (M1BR2550) is designed to measure the performance of the large- and mid-capitalization segments of the Brazilian equity market, covering approximately 85% of the free float-adjusted market capitalization of Brazilian issuers. **One cannot invest directly in an index.**

Investing in a Direxion Shares ETF may be more volatile than investing in broadly diversified funds. The use of leverage by a Fund increases the risk to the Fund. The Fund's adviser, Rafferty Asset Management, LLC ("Rafferty") has entered into an Operating Expense Limitation Agreement with the Fund. Under the Operating Expense Limitation Agreement, Rafferty has contractually agreed to waive all or a portion of its management fee and/or reimburse the Fund for Other Expenses through September 1, 2026, to the extent that the Fund's Total Annual Fund Operating Expenses exceed 0.95% of the Fund's average daily net assets (excluding, as applicable, among other expenses, taxes, swap financing and related costs, acquired fund fees and expenses, dividends or interest on short positions, other interest expenses, brokerage commissions and extraordinary expenses). If these expenses were included, the expense ratio would be higher.

Leverage Risk — The Fund obtains investment exposure in excess of its net assets by utilizing leverage and may lose more money in market conditions that are adverse to its investment objective than a fund that does not utilize leverage. Leverage will also have the effect of magnifying any differences in the Fund's correlation with the Index and may increase the volatility of the Fund.

Daily Index Correlation Risk — A number of factors may affect the Fund's ability to achieve a high degree of correlation with the Index and therefore achieve its daily leveraged investment objective. The Fund's exposure to the Index is impacted by the Index's movement. Because of this, it is unlikely that the Fund will be perfectly exposed to the Index at the end of each day. The possibility of the Fund being materially over- or under-exposed to the Index increases on days when the Index is volatile near the close of the trading day.

Brazilian Securities Risk — Brazilian securities are subject to the risks of the Brazilian economy which has been characterized by frequent and occasionally drastic, interventions by the Brazilian government, including the imposition of wage and price controls, exchange controls, limiting imports, blocking access to bank accounts and other measures.
