

Direxion Daily FinTech Bull 2X Shares

Overview

The [Direxion Daily FinTech Bull 2X Shares](#) seeks daily investment results, before fees and expenses, of 200% of the performance of the Indxx US FinTech and Decentralized Finance Index (IUFDFI). **There is no guarantee that the fund will achieve its stated investment objective.**

This leveraged ETF seeks a return that is 200% of the return of its benchmark index **for a single day. The fund should not be expected to provide two times the return of the benchmark's cumulative return for periods greater than a day.**

Target Index

The Indxx US FinTech and Decentralized Finance Index (IUFDFI) includes U.S.-listed securities, including ADRs, of companies that derive a minimum of 50% of their total revenue from offering technology-driven financial services ("FinTech"), including companies that facilitate decentralized finance systems. Indxx, the Index Provider, defines FinTech as being comprised of the following types of companies: Digital Payments, Point-of-Sale, Personal Finance Software and Credit/Debit Card Issuers, Tax Compliance Software and Backend Payment Processing, Decentralized Finance, Financial Enterprise Solutions, and Peer-to-Peer Lending and Crowdfunding. **One cannot directly invest in an index.**
