Direxion Daily GOOGL Bull 1.5X and Bear 1X Shares

Overview

The <u>Direxion Daily GOOGL Bull 1.5X</u> <u>Shares</u> and <u>Direxion Daily GOOGL Bear 1X</u> <u>Shares</u> seek daily investment results, before fees and expenses, of 150% and 100% of the inverse (or opposite), respectively, of the performance of the Class A shares of Alphabet Inc. (NASDAQ: GOOGL).

Investing in the funds involves a high degree of risk. Unlike traditional ETFs, or even other leveraged and/or inverse ETFs, these leveraged and/or inverse single-stock ETFs track the price of a single stock rather than an index, eliminating the benefits of diversification. Leveraged and inverse ETFs pursue daily leveraged investment objectives, which means they are riskier than alternatives which do not use leverage. They seek daily goals and should not be expected to track the underlying stock's performance over periods longer than one day. They are not suitable for all investors and should be utilized only by investors who understand leverage risk and who actively manage their investments. The Funds will lose money if the underlying stock's performance is flat, and it is possible that the Bull Fund will lose money even if the underlying stock's performance increases, and the Bear Fund will lose money even if the underlying stock's performance decreases, over a period longer than a single day.

Alphabet Inc. provides online advertising services in the United States, Europe, the Middle East, Africa, the Asia-Pacific, Canada, and Latin America. The company offers performance and brand advertising services. GOOGL is registered under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended (the "Exchange Act"). The Funds' adviser, Rafferty Asset Management, LLC ("Rafferty"), has entered into an Operating Expense Limitation Agreement with each Fund. Under the Operating Expense Limitation Agreement, Rafferty has contractually agreed to waive all or a portion of its management fee and/or reimburse the Funds for Other Expenses through September 1, 2024, to the extent that a Fund's Total Annual Fund Operating Expenses exceed 0.95% of the Fund's average daily net assets (excluding, as applicable, among other expenses, taxes, swap financing and related costs, acquired fund fees and expenses, dividends or interest on short positions, other interest expenses, brokerage commissions and extraordinary expenses). If these expenses were included, the expense ratio would be higher.

The Direxion Daily GOOGL Bull 1.5X Shares (GGLL) seeks 150% daily leveraged investment results and thus will have an increase of volatility relative to the underlying GOOGL performance itself. Longer holding periods, higher volatility of GOOGL and leverage increase the impact of compounding on an investor's returns. During periods of higher GOOGL volatility, the volatility of GOOGL may affect the fund's performance.

Important Information Regarding GGLS

The Direxion Daily GOOGL Bear 1X Shares (GGLS) seeks daily inverse investment results and is very different from most other exchange-traded funds. Longer holding periods and higher volatility of GOOGL increase the impact of compounding on an investor's returns. During periods of higher volatility, the volatility of GOOGL may affect the fund's return as much as, or more than, the return of GOOGL.
